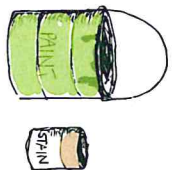

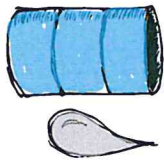

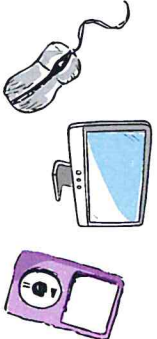

Organics (Compostable Material)

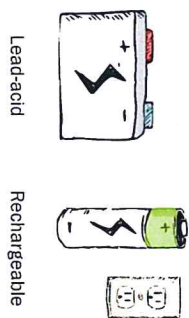
